4 FAM 111.1 Scope and Applicability

(TL:FIN-349; 9-30-94)

a. The Department is required by Title 31, United States Code, Section 11 to submit a budget to the executive branch of the Congress for approval. The Department satisfies this requirement through the submission of its Congressional Budget through the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) to the Congress each year.

b. The Bureau of Finance and Management Policy, Office of Budget and Planning (FMP/BP), is responsible for establishing the Department's policy regarding budget submissions in accordance with OMB Circulars A-11 and A-34 and other pertinent budgetary regulations. The Department's submission to OMB is the basis for obtaining budget authority from the Congress to obligate funds. This authority is in the form of appropriations.

c. FMP/BP provides budget policy and guidance along with detailed instructions and examples to the regional and functional bureaus with respect to budget submissions.

d. Detailed authorities, definitions, and procedures are published in Subchapters 4 FAH-3 H-110 through 4 FAH-3 H-160 .
