

4 FAM 820 MISCELLANEOUS EMPLOYEE SERVICES

4 FAM 821 SCOPE AND APPLICABILITY

(TL:FIN-354; 6-30-95)

a. Post commissaries or employee associations (6 FAM) may provide for the sale of travelers checks to U.S. civilian and military personnel and their dependents when commercial or local sources are not available, as long as it does not conflict with local laws. Likewise, postage stamps, stamped cards, and stamped envelopes may also be sold by the commissaries or employee associations. USDOs or cashiers responsible for official funds are not authorized to sell postage.

b. Consular officers are authorized to certify U.S. securities such as Series E bonds and Freedom Share notes of employees for sending to U.S. banks for encashment.

c. Authorized certifying officers at post may certify employee requests for tax deductions for non-reimbursed representation expenses for submission to IRS (see IRS Publication 516, Tax Information for U.S. Government Civilian Employees Stationed Abroad).

d. Specific requirements and/or procedures for miscellaneous employee services are contained in 4 FAH-3 H-820.
