12 FAH-8 H-441 GENERAL

(TL:RSP-01; 11-01-2001)

a. The primary duty of the post's surveillance detection specialists is to detect pre-operational terrorist surveillance. A by-product of this effort may be the detection of pre-operational criminal surveillance that can be used to thwart criminal activity. It should be clear, however, that detection of possible criminal activities is not an assigned task of the Surveillance Detection Program (SDP).

b. Surveillance detection teams **are not** to be used as mobile patrols or residential guards.

c. RSOs and/or PSOs may have SD teams periodically cover EMRs, PORs, MSGRs or apartments and cluster housing areas where the majority of occupants are U.S. citizen direct-hire employees when reacting to specific threat information.

d. Surveillance detection teams are required to conduct surveys of and write operational plans for each facility and/or residence where they conduct surveillance detection operations.
