a. Where possible, all employees should have a telephone in their residence for use in an emergency situation. If commercial telephone service is unavailable, unreliable, or otherwise unacceptable, consideration should be given to providing two-way radio communications at each residence.

b. If the residence has a safehaven, a means of communication (i.e., telephone or radio) should be located in the safehaven.

c. At some posts, depending on the threat rating, personal radios are issued in accordance with the post's emergency action plan (EAP). Procedures for funding, procurement, use, and maintenance of these radios are the responsibility of the Wireless Services Branch (IRM/OPS/ITI/TWD/WLS).
