

12 FAH-8 H-650 TECHNICAL SECURITY ENHANCEMENT FUNDING

(TL:RSP-01; 11-01-2001)

12 FAH-8 H-651 GENERAL

(TL:RSP-01; 11-01-2001)

a. All residential security technical security enhancements, i.e., alarms, CAMS, lighting, etc., require the same procedures for approval, acquisition and funding regardless of whether the system is destined for a U.S. Government-owned or a leased property. Technical security enhancements are funded through DS/CIS/PSP/FPD and are accounted for under Function Codes 5841 (Residential Security Upgrades) and 5843 (Residential Security Maintenance and Repair). See 12 FAH-8 Appendix III for further information.

b. Technical security enhancements generally do not require a permanent change to a residence. They can and should be removed from leased residences on termination of a lease and reinstalled in other residences.

12 FAH-8 H-652 RESIDENTIAL TECHNICAL SECURITY UPGRADES

(TL:RSP-01; 11-01-2001)

a. Funding requests for residential technical security upgrades (accounted for under Function Code 5841) should be submitted to DS/CIS/PSP/FPD. A detailed narrative must be provided as part of post's request for funds. The narrative should include:

- (1) Post specific threat rating rationale for the proposed upgrade(s);
- (2) Type (single-family, apartment, townhouse, etc.) and number of residences to be affected;
- (3) Comments of EAC and/or COM;
- (4) Itemized list of required equipment including cost estimates;
- (5) Shipping costs if required; and
- (6) Installation costs.

b. For routine and ordinary operation, program funding of residential technical security equipment should be included in the Non-ICASS portion of post's annual International Cooperative Administrative Support Services (ICASS) budget submission. The estimate for costs should include installation, maintenance, repair, and spare parts as well as the original purchase price for replacement equipment.

12 FAH-8 H-653 MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR (M&R)

(TL:RSP-01; 11-01-2001)

a. Maintenance and repair of the residential technical security enhancements are the responsibility of the mission. Items, such as a CAMS, may require a service contract with the provider of the CAMS. Certain equipment such as lighting can usually be maintained and repaired by the General Services (GS) section. Funding for maintenance and repair is normally accounted for under Function Code 5843. A post's initial FY estimates of M&R expenditures should be explained and included in the post's annual ICASS budget submission.

b. If additional funding is required during a fiscal year due to exceptional circumstances, post should address requests to DS/CIS/PSP/FPD including a full narrative justification and estimate of the additional funding required.
