12 FAH-8 H-731 GENERAL

a. U.S. citizen direct-hire employees of the U.S. Agency for International Development (USAID) and their eligible family members are provided the same level of protection as the eligible family members and employees of the Department and other U.S. Government agencies at post.

b. U.S. citizen employees of USAID hired in the United States under contract to the agency and their eligible family members are provided the same level of protection as the eligible family members and employees of the Department and other agencies at post.

c. U.S. citizen employees of USAID hired under contract, in the host country, **are not** provided residential security protection by the Department as part of the RSP.

12 FAH-8 H-732 USAID OPTIONS

In some circumstances, USAID facilities or residences are not co-located with other mission facilities. For example, a U.S. citizen direct-hire employee may be assigned to a research facility at a remote site. USAID may believe a different level of security for the employee and/or their family is required. A request explaining the reasons for the different requirements, along with comments by the RSO and the post's emergency action committee (EAC), should be sent to the Facilities Protection Division (DS/CIS/PSP/FPD) for consideration and approval prior to changing the residential security provided to the USAID employee.

12 FAH-8 H-733 FUNDING

(TL:RSP-01; 11-01-2001)

a. RSP required physical and technical residential security enhancements at residences assigned to USAID U.S. citizen direct-hire employees are funded and provided by DS/CIS/PSP/FPD.

b. USAID U.S. citizen contract employees covered by the RSP are authorized the same residential security enhancements as other U.S. citizen direct-hire employees. These enhancements are generally funded through inclusion of the costs in the employee's contract and directly reimbursed at post.

c. When USAID is provided residential guard services through the post's RSP, the costs of providing this protection are charged to USAID at post on a pro rata shared basis.
